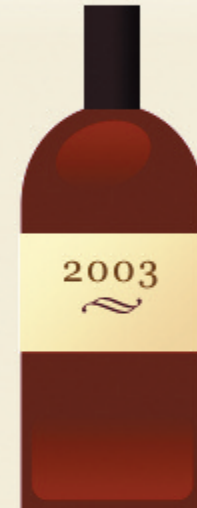

Nice drinking wine now but it's young and will benefit from some time in the bottle. Starts with a bright cross between cherry and cranberry and then moves onto a very nice dirty blackberry flavor.

Cameron Confidential: This blend of four different wines comes mainly from wineries with one grower wine represented. All of these components come from Lake County vineyards with wineries located in Sonoma, Napa, and Lake County. Those of you who have been with us long enough will remember our first Lake County wine, Lot 3 Petite Sirah, and start drooling. I love Lake County wines and I am happy to bring another one to the table. The primary components of this wine were grown on high-elevation plateaus all spent about 12 months in oak, mostly neutral barrels.
